RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN BOARD OF THE TOWN OF HALIFAX, NORTH CAROLINA, IN OPPOSITION TO THE CLOSURE OF HALIFAX BRANCH OF TRUIST BANK

WHEREAS, Truist Bank and its predecessors, the Bank of Halifax and BB&T Bank, have since 1906 enjoyed the loyalty and business of the citizens of the Town of Halifax and the surrounding area; and

WHEREAS, the Halifax Branch of Truist Bank is the only banking institution in the Town, and by function and location serves as a cornerstone of the commercial life of the Town; and

WHEREAS, new enterprises have recently begun to revitalize the business district and neighborhoods of the Town by promoting the unique commercial, archaeological, cultural, and historic properties of the Town; and

WHEREAS, the citizens of Halifax and these enterprises are in great need of a banking partner to continue these revitalization efforts; and

WHEREAS, the closure of the Halifax Branch of Truist Bank would surely greatly impede, and possibly stymie, these efforts.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED,

That the Town Board of the Town of Halifax goes on record as strongly opposing the closure of the Halifax Branch of Truist Bank, and further, urge Truist Bank to remain true to its 116-year history of service to the Town of Halifax by remaining a vital part of the life of the Town.
